## Community Workshop for Nixa Area Trail Study

The Ozarks Transportation Organization and the City of Nixa are hosting a community workshop to explore opportunities for new trails and greenways linking the City of Nixa to the regional trail network on Tuesday, April 17. We would like to learn about the ideas and aspirations of Nixa residents for trails in and around the City. The community workshop will take place at *The X Center*, 701 N. Taylor Way, Nixa, from 4:30 to 6:30pm. Citizens will have the opportunity to share their ideas by drawing potential trail locations and identifying trail destinations on the area maps. There will also be comment forms for people to fill out if they have additional thoughts to share with the study team.

The Nixa Area Trail Study builds on the regional Long Range Transportation Plan (2017) and the Regional Bicycle & Pedestrian Trail Investment Study (2017), two planning documents that identify future trails across the Springfield Metro Area. This study will identify new trails in and around Nixa, connecting to Ozark, Springfield, and many of the existing and planned trails in the surrounding region, such as the James River Greenway, the Finley Creek Greenway, and Wilson's Creek Greenway. The study will also identify opportunities to link Nixa residents and visitors to schools, parks, retail, and other important community destinations.
