

Demographic Profile of OTO Region

- Population growth increases diversity: 2022 86.4% white, 3.3% Black of African American, 2.3% percent Asian compared to 90.1% white, 3.1% Black of African American, 1.9% Asian in 2019
- Two or more race population grows from 9,927 in 2019 to 20,023 in 2022 (101.7% increase)
- ► Hispanic or Latino population increases by 38.8% compared to 2019 to 16.269 (4.6% of OTO population)







- ► <u>Factor 1</u>: The **Number or Proportion** of LEP Persons Served or Encountered in the Eligible Service Population
- ► <u>Factor 2</u>: The **Frequency** with which LEP Individuals Come into Contact with an MPO Program, Activity, or Service
- Factor 3: The Nature and Importance of the Program, Activity, or Service Provided by the MPO to LEP Community
- ► Factor 4: The **Resources Available** to the MPO and Overall Costs

Concentrations of All Persons 5+ Years of Age Who Speak English "Less than Very Well"


